



# Notice of upcoming works, A425, Southam

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

## The work we will be doing

Works are needed to allow the A425 temporary diversion road to be connected to the existing highway. Works will be carried out between **16 January 2023 and 17 February 2023**.

To carry out these works safely, single lane closures with temporary traffic lights and one overnight full closure will be required.

## When we will be doing the works

Two way temporary traffic lights will be in place at two points on the A425 from **16 January 2023 to 17 February 2023** (please see map one and map two).

Overnight full closure, **6 February 2023**, between the hours of **10pm and 6am**. A full diversion will be in place (please see map three).

## Access to all properties will be maintained.

Our workforce maybe on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

Single lane closures and temporary traffic lights will be in place on the A425 between 16 January 2023 and 17 February 2023.

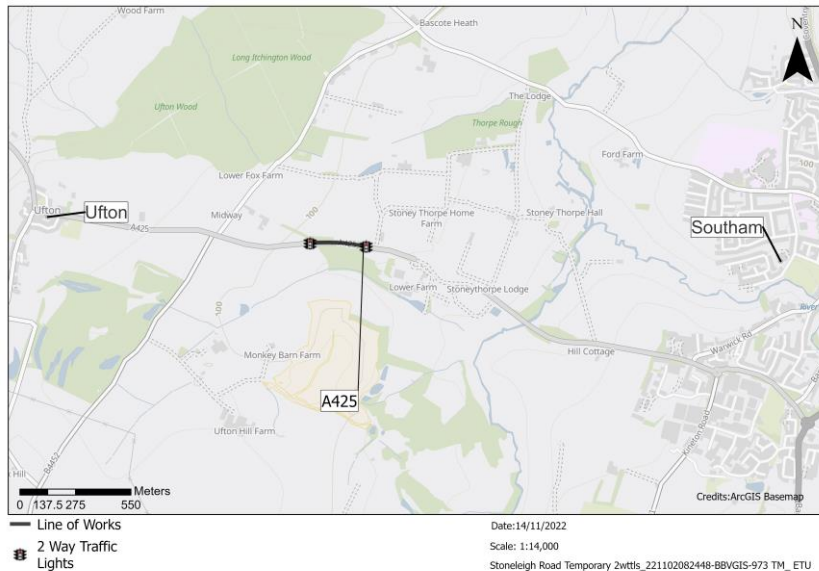

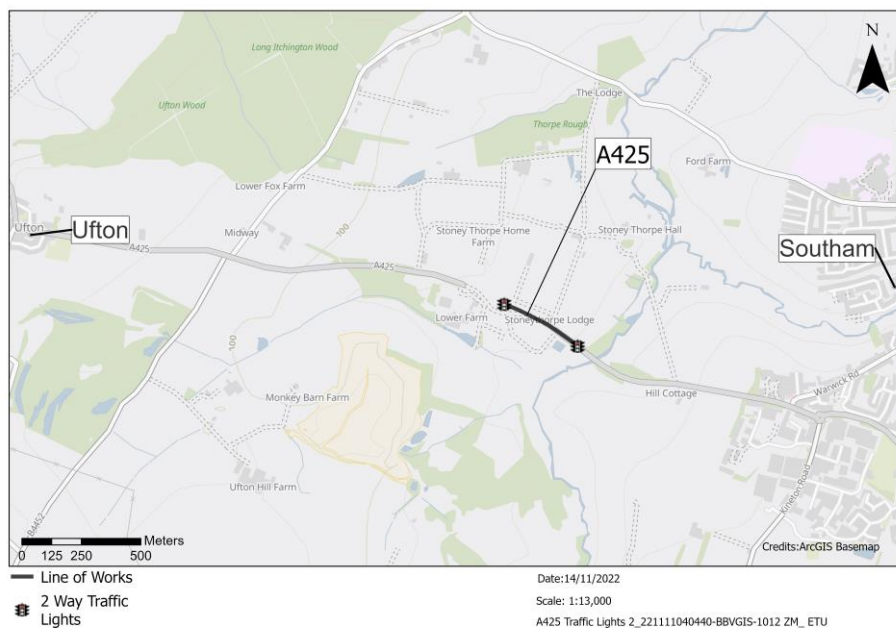
